# 2019 Thornton Park Varsity Tournament

## General Information and Rules - Varsity

**Coaches, please advise parents that admission fees are charged for each game.**

1. Entry Fee: the **\$875.00 entry fee** is due prior to **Friday, November 1, 2019**. Please make checks payable to: The City of Shaker Heights and mail to: **Bill Murray**, c/o Thornton Park, 3301 Warrensville Center Road, Shaker Heights, OH 44122
2. **Tournament Director: Mike Berg (Michael.Berg@shakeronline.com, 216-491-2586)**
3. All OHSAA and NFHS rules apply to each contest.
4. All teams are guaranteed 3 games in a bracket format.
5. Roster and pass lists: please submit to **Mike Berg** prior to **November 20, 2019**.

**Pass lists are limited to 10 individuals.**

6. Jersey Color: The team listed on the top line of the bracket will be the home team and will wear the light color jersey. Shaker Heights is always the home team.
7. Team Bench: the home team bench is located nearest the lobby.
8. Time Outs: one time out per team, per game, including overtime periods.
9. Regulation: 15 minute periods. 10 minute warm up prior to first period.
10. Overtime: all overtime periods will be five (5) minutes in length with a three (3) minute break between periods. Overtime #1: 4 on 4, Overtime #2: 3 on 3. Penalties during 3 on 3 play will be played as 4 on 3. Overtime #3: 5 man shoot out. Overtime #4: 1 man shoot out. The game will end as a sudden victory.

Championship Game Only: Two eight (8) minute periods of 5 on 5 sudden victory play before following the above overtime procedure starting with overtime #3. Three (3) minute break between all overtime periods. No ice cuts.

11. Running Time: the game clock will run at any point in the game where there is a 7 goal differential. Stop time will resume when a 5 goal differential is reached.
  12. Ice Cuts: Varsity games – unless otherwise noted, ice cuts will be performed in between each period. Ice cuts may be skipped as determined by tournament director(s) to keep the tournament on schedule. There will be no ice cuts made in overtime periods.
  13. Awards: Championship and Runner-up team trophies will be presented and 25 medallions per team will be provided for members of the championship and runner-up teams only.
  14. **Coaches**: Please remind your team that the City of Shaker Heights **is not responsible** for lost or stolen items. Leave wallets, iPods, cell phones, etc. in a safe place. To minimize the potential of theft or vandalism, locker room restrooms and showers will be open for access to teams who are on the ice. Teams preparing to go on the ice will need to use lobby restrooms.
